

DIRECTIONS TO FIELDS USED BY THE CONESTOGA VALLEY YOUTH SOCCER CLUB

TO CONESTOGA VALLEY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL FIELDS

From the West and North

Travel Route 30 East. Take the exit for Route 340 (Old Philadelphia Pike), turning right at the top of the ramp onto Route 340, heading East. At the next traffic light, turn left onto Horseshoe Road. Travel just over a mile. The High School is on the right. One U-10 girls' field is on the near (west) side of the high school, in the back right corner of the property. All other fields are on the far (east) side of the high school.

From the East and South

Travel Route 30 West, past Dutch Wonderland. At the State Police Barracks (across from East Towne Mall), turn right at the traffic light onto Oakview Road. At the next light (a "T"), turn left onto Route 340 (Old Philadelphia Pike). In only a hundred yards, turn right onto Horseshoe Road. Travel just over a mile. The High School is on the right. One U-10 girls' field is on the near (west) side of the high school, in the back right corner of the property. All other fields are on the far (east) side of the high school.

TO CONESTOGA VALLEY MIDDLE SCHOOL FIELDS

Same as above. Travel on Horseshoe Road past the High School. At the traffic light, turn right onto Mt. Sydney Road. The Middle School is on the right. Take the road on the left side of the school, and park in back of the school.

TO LEOLA ELEMENTARY

From Route 30:

Take the exit for Route 23 (New Holland Pike) East. (If Eastbound on 30, turn right at the top of the ramp onto Route 23; if traveling West on 30, turn left at the top of the ramp.) Travel Route 23 East (3-4 miles) into Leola. Turn left at the traffic light by Subway onto Route 772 West/North (Glen Brook Road). Go about a hundred yards and turn right into the school. The field is straight ahead and to the left.

From the East:

Travel Route 23 (New Holland Pike) West into Leola. Turn right (at the traffic light by Subway) onto Route 772 West/North. Go about a hundred yards and turn right into the school. The field is straight ahead and to the left.

TO PRACTICE FIELDS BEHIND UPPER LEACOCK TOWNSHIP BUILDING

From the West:

Travel Route 23 East into Leola. Go through the traffic light by Subway. Turn right at the next light onto Route 772 East/South (Newport Road). At the next crossroads (just before the Railroad crossing), turn left onto Glenola Drive. Proceed about a hundred yards and turn left to park in the grass along the road, behind the school.

From the East:

Travel Route 23 (New Holland Pike) West into Leola. Across from the entrance to the Leola Community Pool and Park, turn left onto Glenola Drive. Just past Ethel Avenue, turn right to park in the grass along the road, behind the school.

TO PRACTICE FIELDS BEHIND BROWNSTOWN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

From Route 272:

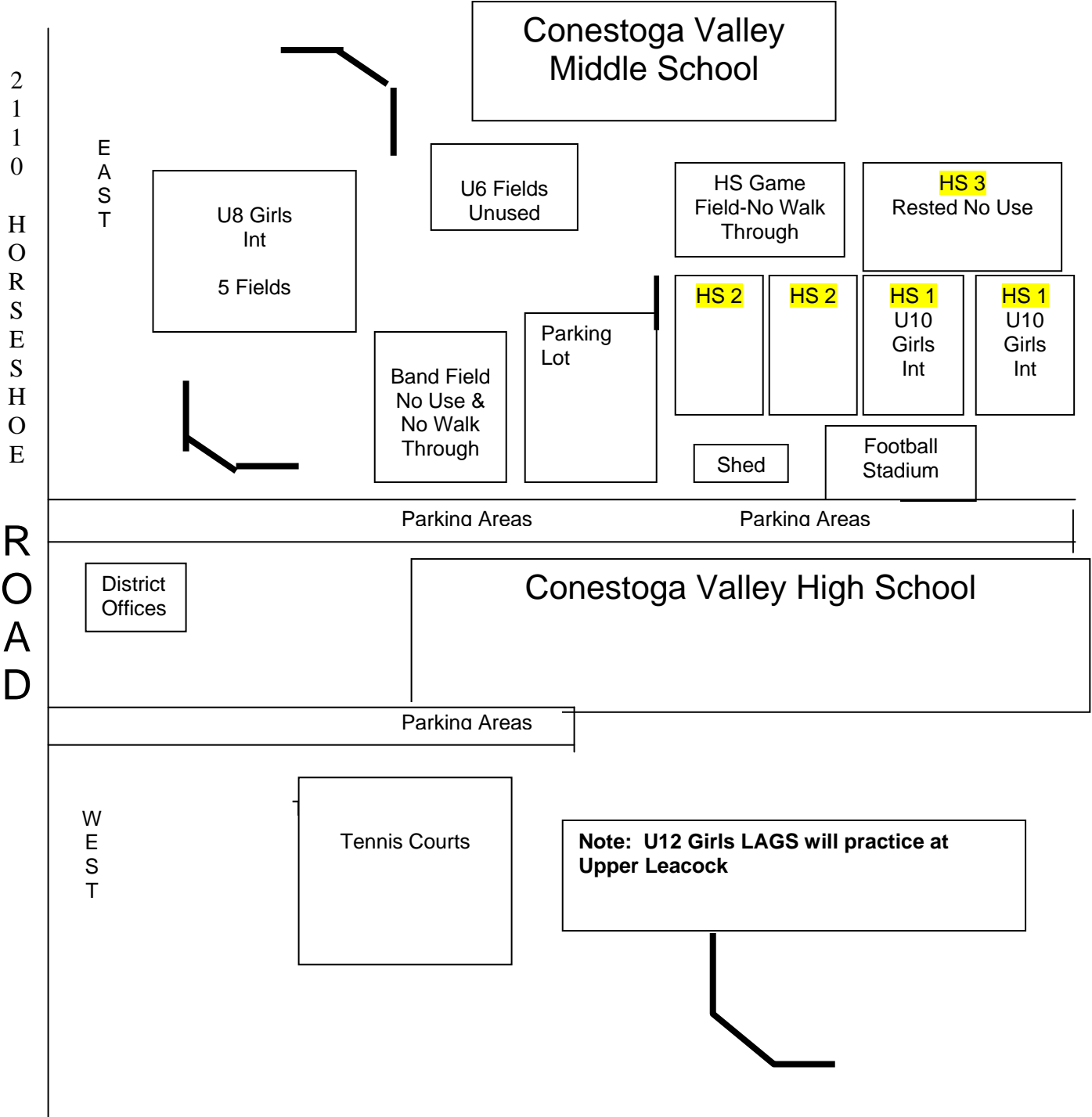
From Route 272, turn at the Newport Road light and travel a few blocks southeast into Brownstown. (Newport Road is also called State Street here). Go through the traffic light, crossing Main Street. Proceed one block. Turn left onto School Lane. The school is at the end of the block, on the right

From Route 772 (Leola):

From Leola, take Route 772 West/North (Newport Road) into Brownstown. (Newport Road will become State Street). Turn right onto School Lane. The school is at the end of the block, on the right.

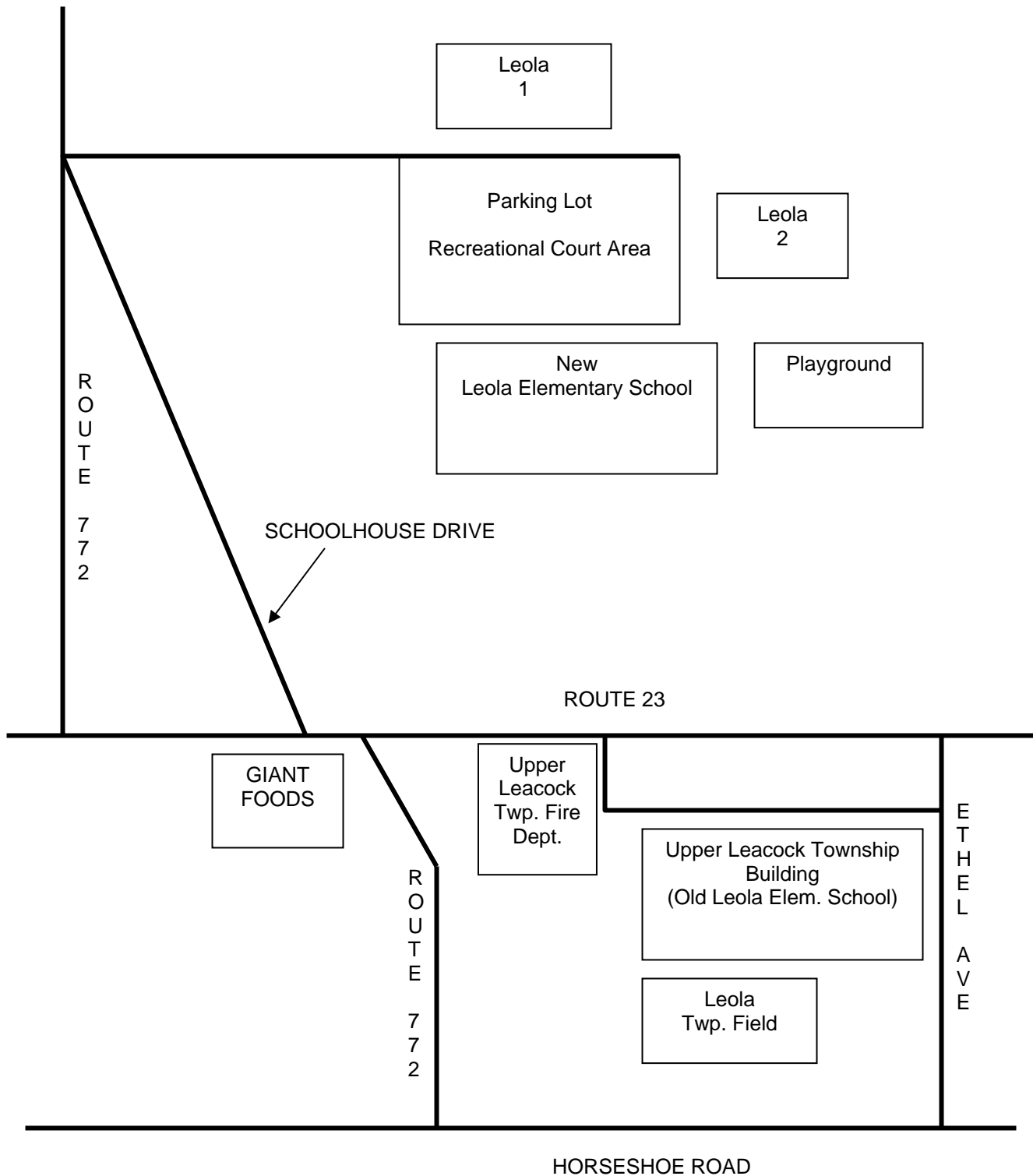

Field sizes for the U10, U11/U12 and U14 & Up age groups may vary slightly from the dimensions listed

Goals 4' x 8' are made with PVC pipes and are portable.

Goals 7' x 21' are used for the U10 programs. Four sets are at the High School and the other set is at Leola Elementary.

Goals 8' x 24' are located on the east side of the High School, Leola Elementary, and the Leola Township Building (old Leola Elementary School).

FIELD AVAILABILITY

Practice Times: Regular practice times and locations will be established at the beginning of each season by each age coordinator in consultation with the Fields Coordinator.

In order to schedule a make-up PRACTICE on CVYSC fields, coaches will need to call the Fields Coordinator to ascertain field availability. Regularly scheduled practices or games (either of CVYSC or other CV school programs) will take precedence. Canceling or rescheduling of practices is at the discretion of the coach.

Canceling and Rescheduling of GAMES ought to occur in consultation with the age coordinator, and with both coaches in agreement as to time and place. Coaches need to call the Referee Coordinator right away to cancel scheduled referees and arrange for referees for the rescheduled time. It is also necessary to consult with the Fields Coordinator to ascertain field availability for the make-up game. In order for a game to be permanently canceled the age coordinator must give approval. (LANCO teams must reschedule games within 7-10 days, working with the LANCO Representative and Field Coordinator.)

EQUIPMENT

(What is available and how to get it)

At the beginning of each season, age coordinators will arrange for the distribution of equipment to coaches. Coaches must sign out their equipment and are personally responsible for its safe return at the end of the season. Age coordinators in conjunction with the equipment coordinator will arrange for the collection of equipment at the close of the season.

Each coach will normally receive an equipment bag that contains the following:

- (5) Balls (of age appropriate size, including one game ball)
- (1) Basic First Aid Kit
- (4) to (12) pinneys*
- (1) Pump
- (1) Goalie Shirt for LANCO and intramural teams as needed

*Depends on age division; more if for older teams

NOTE: RETURN DEFECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO THE EQUIPMENT COORDINATOR AND IT WILL BE REPLACED.

Other available equipment that can be obtained through the equipment coordinator:

Portable goals – 6' x 12'

UNIFORMS

A reversible team shirt can be purchased by each player at registration. For teams playing in LCGSA or LCBSA , the Uniform Coordinator, with the Team Parent Coordinator, will contact the Team Parent for each team to distribute the uniforms for their team. Players competing at the LANCO level are required to purchase uniforms through the club. These uniforms will be used of two years of play. This includes both fall and spring seasons for two years.
